RCU Holding Holiday Food & Bear Drive

Eau Claire, WI – During the month of November, RCU is sponsoring a community-wide Holiday Food & Bear Drive. Members and non-members can bring non-perishable food (cans and unopened packaged food items) and/or new stuffed bears to any RCU office by November 30th. Now more than ever, you can take a moment to make a difference to others in your community!

RCU Volunteers will be picking up and keeping track of the donated items from each RCU office. Donated food items will be delivered to food pantries and the stuffed bears will be distributed to children in each of the local communities where we have an office.

“This year especially, a gesture of donating food or a stuffed animal can make a huge difference in someone’s life,” states, Becky Glass, RCU Marketing Specialist. “Last year, Members and non-Members collected over 400 bears and over 950 pounds of food for local organizations. This has been a tough year for a number of individuals and families, and your donations will go a long way.”

RCU is especially hoping for an increase in donations this year due to the addition of offices in ten new communities, including Amery, Balsam Lake, Centuria, Milltown, New Richmond, Osceola, River Falls, Somerset, St. Croix Falls, and Star Prairie. With the addition of these new offices within the past year, a campaign such as the Food & Bear Drive can be even more successful than it has been in the past.

In 1993, RCU developed the RCU Volunteer Program to promote volunteerism and community spirit. The program is structured to reward those who volunteer at least four hours per month anywhere in the community. Currently, RCU has almost 500 RCU Volunteers who volunteer over 30,000 hours of their time each year to help make our communities a better place to live!
